## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

### FALDO SERIES PHILIPPINES CHAMPIONSHIP 2010

TAT Filipinas Golf Club Inc. (TFGCI), known for its advocacy of a sustainable golf course and social initiatives, will host the 2010 Faldo Series Philippines Championship on May 24-26, 2010 as part of the Faldo Series Asia (FSA) and in cooperation with the Junior Golf Foundation of the Philippines. The FSA is supported by major partners The R&A, Mission Hills and ISPS and endorsed by the Asian Tour and the Asia Pacific Golf Federation.

1. DATE & VENUE : May 24-26, 2010  
: TAT Filipinas Golf Club

TFGCI is an 18-hole par 72 golf course beautifully integrated in a critically diverse habitat. It is 7,098 yards long with a course and slope rating of 72.2 and 131 from the blue tees respectively. It has hosted important golfing events such as the Philippine Open and the Ericsson Tour among others.

2. CONDITIONS : Open to the 1st 120 players

Age Categories:

Boys Under-21 born 1989-1991

Boys Under-18 born 1992-1993

Boys Under-16 born 1994-1998

Girls Under-21 born 1989-1993

Girls Under-16 born 1994-1998

The tournament will be played over 54 holes with no cut. The format will be gross stroke-play with medals awarded to the boys' under-21 winner, the boys' under-18 winner, the boys' under-16 winner, the girls' under-21 winner and the girls' under-16 winner.

Players will be allocated their age-category according to their age on 1 January 2010. Boys will play from the blue tees (approx 6,500 yards) and girls will play from the white tees (approx 6,100 yards). A Caddie Fee of a minimum of P400/round is payable direct to the caddie immediately after play. Further tournament conditions and player briefing notes will be provided during tournament registration.

The winner of each age category will qualify for the Faldo Series Asia Grand Final at Mission Hills Golf Club in Shenzhen, China in March 2011. The FSA will cover the following costs: transfers between Mission Hills and the Hong Kong China-border; twin-share hotel accommodation; official meals (breakfast and dinner); two practice rounds and three tournament rounds; player seminars and clinics; and official apparel.

### 3. REGISTRATION

You may also register via email at [jungolf1976@yahoo.com](mailto:jungolf1976@yahoo.com). **Entry Fee is P2500** inclusive of golf clinic, lunch during the awarding and giveaways. **Deadline of Entry is on May 15 at 5:00PM. Only paid entries will be included in the pairings.**

### 4. TIME AND ORDER OF STARTING

Players must be in the starter's area 10 minutes before their scheduled tee-off time. If a player is not present or is not ready to play when his name is called by the Starter for his scheduled tee-time, the player shall be assessed a 2 stroke penalty. The five (5) minute rule shall then be applied. If the player fails to start after the five (5) minute rule, the player shall be disqualified.

If the starter is notified in advance that a player will be delayed past his scheduled tee-off time because of an automobile failure, accident, etc, the tournament director may grant an exemption. Late arrival due to failure to allow sufficient traveling time is not acceptable.

### 5. BREAKING TIES

Ties for first place will be settled by sudden-death play-off on the eighteenth (18th) hole. All other ties shall be settled by count back beginning with the scores on the last 9 holes (10 – 18), then if still tied, the scores on the last 6 holes (13-18), then if still tied, the last three holes (16-18), and if still necessary, hole by hole count-back starting from hole no. 18. If a sudden death cannot be played due to darkness, time constraints or bad weather, the tournament director can declare the players as co-champions.

### 6. PACE OF PLAY

USGA Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who, by their pace, contribute to such delay. The golf course marshal shall issue warnings and possibly penalties if violation of slow play is continuously incurred.

## 7. LOCAL RULES

Players, in all classes, shall take no more than the maximum 10 strokes on any hole. Once this score has been attained, the player shall cease play on that hole, pick-up the ball and wait for the fellow competitors to complete the hole. This maximum score will be his score for that hole. All other local rules shall be followed.

## 8. SPECTATOR / GALLERY GUIDELINES:

It is a privilege for parents, guardians and spectators to watch the junior golfers during the tournament, however this privilege may be taken away if a violation of the JGFP CODES OF CONDUCT is incurred. All spectators must register at the registration desk prior to entering the fairway. JGFP CODES OF CONDUCT shall be posted at the Registration Area, and shall be distributed upon registration of the spectator.

Gallery is allowed with a concessional fee of P500 representing gallery fee of P200 and a consumable fee of P300.00. Consumable fee can be used to buy food/beverage at the Club restaurant and/or tee houses. Club rules and regulations concerning galleries and golf rules particularly golf etiquette must be strictly adhered to. Management reserves the right to suspend this privilege or deny anybody access to the golf course for any reason.

## 9. CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

The Tournament Director shall have the sole authority on the conduct of the tournament and the right to change/amend the conditions of play to insure the success of the tournament.

## 10. RULES OF GOLF

The Rules of Golf of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the USGA and the local rules of the host Golf Club will govern play. Questions shall be settled by the Tournament Director whose decision shall be final.

## 11. CLOSE OF COMPETITION

The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the Championship trophy has been presented. Protests shall not be accepted after the tournament.
